12.–14. week		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>measurement of the nuchal translucency</li> </ul>
14.–16. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>routine care</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>additional sonography</b></li> <li>toxoplasmosis, cytomegaly, thyroid check</li> </ul>
16.–20. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>routine care</li> <li>blood check for hemoglobin</li> </ul>	
19.–22. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>routine care</li> <li><b>2<sup>nd</sup> sonography screening</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>sonographic measurement of cervical length</b> (AOK)</li> </ul>
22.–25. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>routine care</li> </ul>	
25.–28. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>routine care</li> <li>blood check for hemoglobin and antibodies</li> <li>blood sugar test (OGITT)</li> <li>in case of pre-term contractions cardiotocography (CTG)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>additional sonography</b> (poss. using 3D/4D ultrasound)</li> </ul>
29.–32. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>3<sup>rd</sup> sonography screening</b></li> <li>routine care</li> <li>blood check for hemoglobin</li> <li>Anti-D injection for rh-neg. women</li> <li>in case of pre-term contractions cardiotocography (CTG)</li> <li>vaccination for pertussis</li> </ul>	
32.–35. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>routine care</li> <li>cardiotocography (CTG)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>additional sonography</b></li> </ul>
35./36. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>routine care</li> <li>blood check for hepatitis B and hemoglobin</li> <li>cardiotocography (CTG)</li> <li>in case of a abnormal position of the baby, a sonography exam</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>smear test for B-Streptococcus</li> <li>blood check for Hepatitis C</li> <li><b>additional sonography</b> for planing the birth mode (DAK)</li> </ul>
37./38. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>routine care</li> <li>cardiotocography (CTG)</li> </ul>	
39./40. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>routine care</li> <li>cardiotocography (CTG)</li> </ul>	
after due day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>routine care</li> <li>check up every second day with CTG, and check up of the amniotic fluid with the sonography</li> </ul>
