25.–28. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • routine care • blood check for hemoglobin and antibodies • blood sugar test (OGITT) • in case of pre-term contractions cardiotocography (CTG) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • additional sonography (poss. using 3D/4D ultrasound)
29.–32. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3rd sonography screening • routine care • blood check for hemoglobin • Anti-D injection for rh-neg. women • in case of pre-term contractions cardiotocography (CTG) • vaccination for pertussis 	
32.–35. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • routine care • cardiotocography (CTG) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • additional sonography
35./36. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • routine care • blood check for hepatitis B and hemoglobin • cardiotocography (CTG) • in case of a abnormal position of the baby, a sonography exam 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • smear test for B-Streptococcus • blood check for Hepatitis C • additional sonography for planing the birth mode
37./38. week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • routine care • cardiotocography (CTG)

after due day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • routine care • check up every second day with CTG, and check up of the amniotic fluid with the sonography
